Dear Northeast London, Integrated Care System and Partners

**Child Protection – Information Sharing (CP-IS) service - Phase 2**

**The purpose for CP-IS is to share information securely between Local Authorities and NHS organisations to protect vulnerable children within England who are open to children’s social care on a Child Protection Plan including unborn or a Looked After Child.**

Phase 1 has successfully established itself as the sole national register for social care status and the exclusive system for providing information in cases where a child is out of area. It is utilised by all local authorities and accessible at over 1,200 unscheduled health care sites, demonstrating its comprehensive reach and effectiveness.

The next step in the CPIS roll out is to introduce Phase 2.

Scheduled care to be included in phase 2 includes:

- General Practice (in hours) (CPIS used via a silent read only)
- Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS all tiers)
- Sexual Assault Referral Centres (CPIS used via a silent read only)
- Termination of pregnancy services (CPIS used via a silent read only)
- School nursing and Health visitors (0-19 services)
- Community paediatrics
- Community paediatric Dentistry (specialist services)

The Designated Nurses for safeguarding children in the Northeast London place-based areas will lead Phase 2 and report to the ICB on progress. This process will be conducted in collaboration with health providers across the Northeast London health landscape. The anticipated timeline for completion is 12 months.
